



SSC WINTER SAILING EVENTS INCLUDING THE FROSTBITE SERIES ARE SUSPENDED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

This notice is effective December 19th, 2009.

Recent events at the club have prompted a review by the Executive Committee of the liability insurance carried by SSC.

The risk profile submitted to the insurer is a couple of years old and informed the insurer that organized sailing events at the club end in October and do not start again until April, and that all sailing events are supported by a tower crew and rescue boat with a licensed operator.

SSC has written to the insurer to update our profile and advise them of the informal winter sailing that takes place, but have yet to receive a response.

We are hopeful that the insurer will approve winter sailing, but there may be conditions attached with respect to notices, waivers, rescue facilities etc.

In the meantime, pending a response from our insurer, the Executive Committee has regrettably decided it must suspend any further organized winter sailing events (i.e., events held prior to opening day, 2010) at the club, including the Frostbite Series, until further notice.
